



2012 CAA Shooter of the Year Awards

The CAA will be presenting 4 Shooter of the Year Awards in 2011. Awards will be presented for the following 4 categories:

- Adult
- Senior (includes Master Senior)
- Women
- Junior (under 18)

To qualify, archers must compete in the following:

- **1 Indoor Championship** (CAA Indoor Open or NFAA Indoor Championship)
- **1 Outdoor Championship** (CAA Outdoor Open or NFAA Field Championship)
- **CAA 3D Championship**

NOTE: Archers must be valid CAA members at the time of each shoot. Archers must compete within the same category for all 3 qualifying tournaments.

Archers will earn points in each tournament above based upon the archers place and the numbers of competitors in their division for that shoot. Points will be determined by dividing the number of competitors (*within an archer's division for that shoot*) by the archer's place (*within their division for that shoot*). Points will be added at the end of the year to determine the CAA Shooter of the year for each of the 4 categories.

NOTE: Archers competing in more than 1 Indoor Championship and/or more than 1 Outdoor Championship will have their higher point total for the shoot type count towards Shooter of the Year.
